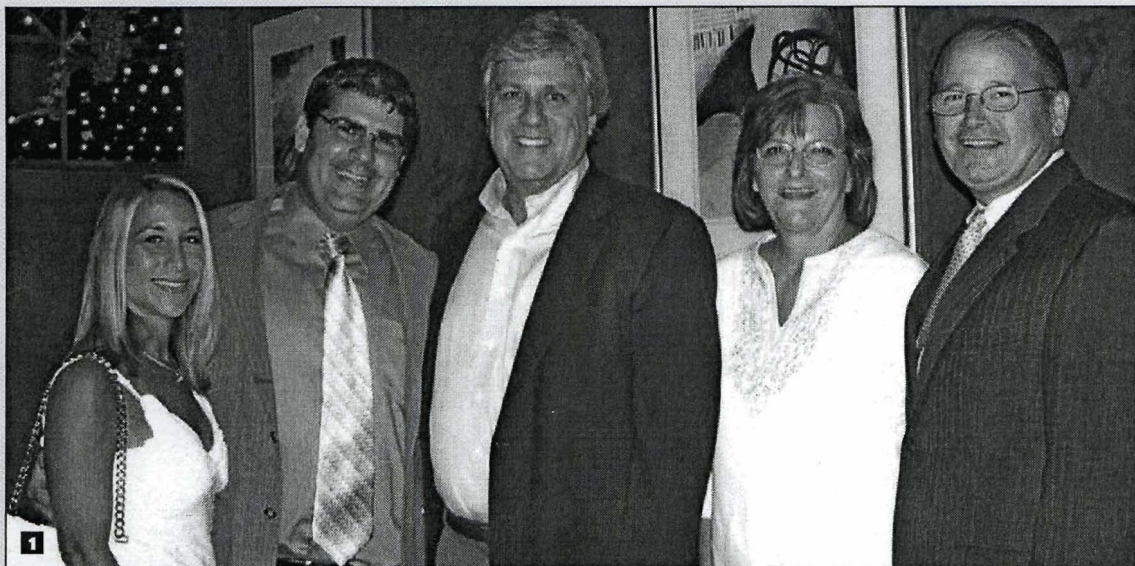


Jack Furnari hits 50
