Recent Zonta meeting dedicated to promoting status of women

BOCA RATON — The Zonta Club of the Boca Raton Area dedicated a recent meeting entirely to promoting the status of women with the new Mayor of Boca Raton Carol Hanson as keynote speaker.

Mayor Hanson, a former 12-year member of the Florida Legislature who served as a House Minority Whip for four years, exemplifies the achievements that can be accomplished by a woman in the 90s. She has been initiated as an Honorary Member of the Zonta Club. During her tenure in the Florida Legislature, she introduced the anti-stalking bill that has become law in this state.

This year's recipient is Nichole Michelle Marsala, a student at Stoneman Douglas High School, in Parkland. Marsala is now eligible for

another scholarship on the Zonta District 11 level, and if she wins there, can also compete on an international level. Marsala was also given a summer apprenticeship to work with Mary McCarty, head of the Palm Beach County Commissioners.

In addition, the Zonta Club has sponsored a student in the Community Apprenticeship Program at the Deerfield Middle School.

The CAP, in which more than 30 students are enrolled, is designed to help the student's self-esteem, develop marketable skills and motivate students to continue their education. This year's student is Genna Pendergast, and she is going to school and working as an apprentice to Molly Reynolds, owner of the Venous Hair Salon in Deerfield Beach. Pendergast was also honored at the evening's festivities, as well as Patricia Barlow, coordinator of the CAP program. Zonta will be hosting the CAP Program's graduation party and has been selected to sponsor at least 10 students for the coming year.

All in all, members and guests left the dinner with even more dedication to promote the status of women, not only in the local community, but worldwide.

Zonta International also supports Unifem, the United Nations Fund for Women, and is the largest single contributor, second only to the U.S. Government.
